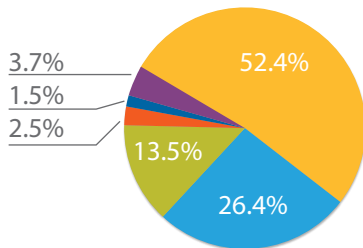

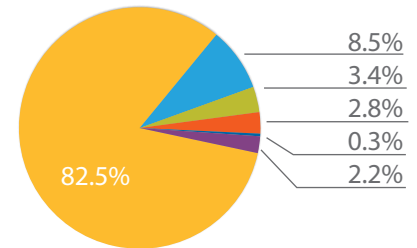

Whites in Private Schools 1998-2012



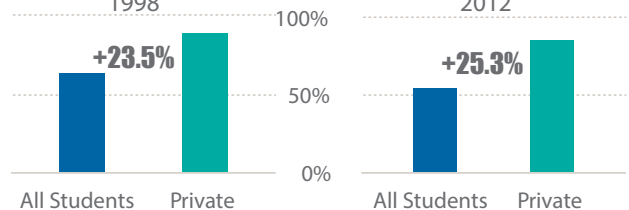
In 1998, 8 percent of all white students in North Carolina were enrolled in private schools. In 2012, the number jumped to 8.6 percent.

Black, Hispanic, and Native American in Private Schools 1998-2012



In 1998, 1.7 percent of B, H, NA, students in North Carolina were in private schools. In 2012, it was 1.7 percent.

Overrepresentation of Whites in Private Schools



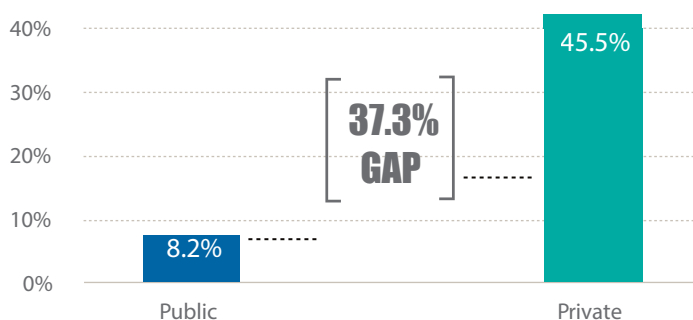
5th Highest in the Nation

In 1998, 65.1 percent of school-age children in NC were white, but 88.6 percent of private school students were white.

5th Highest in the Nation

In 2012, 57.1 percent of school-age children in NC were white, but 82.5 percent of private school students were white.

In North Carolina, 8.2 percent of white students in public schools attend virtually segregated public schools. In private schools, 45.5 percent of white students attend virtually segregated schools.
